

BG Amy Courter Elected as National Vice Commander

Brigadier General Amy Courter, the National Acting Commander, has been re-elected as the National Vice Commander for 2007-2008. There were no nominations from the floor for this position.

In a smooth run on the agenda items, the candidates recommended by the National Commander for National Chief of Staff, the National Legal Officer, the National Finance Officer, the National Controller and the National Chief of Chaplain Services have been appointed to these posts by a vote of the National Board.

National Board minutes from the March 2007 meeting were approved as distributed.

An agenda item calling for the National Commander to have a second term was defeated by a vote of 58 "no" to 5 "yes". An agenda item for the extension of the term of Region Commander was postponed indefinitely. An item to extend the term of of Wing Commanders was withdrawn.

An item to nominate Maj Gen Bowling to the CAP Hall of Honor was postponed until the Winter National Board.

An item to establish a National Commander's Emergency Services Competition was postponed until the Winter Board Meeting.

An item to approve a change in the organizational structure to abolish the position of Group Inspector General and allow Wing Commanders to appoint in their stead, multiple Wing Assistant Inspectors General was approved.

An item to approve the requirement of notice of all membership suspensions be sent to National Headquarters, leading to an annotation on the member's record and the termination of membership privileges including eServices access was approved.
