### Hurricane Hanna Update

In response to Hurricane Hanna, the State Emergency Operation Center (SEOC) has declared Operations Control (OPCON) 4 effective 1400 local, Monday, 1 September 2008.

Although the SEOC is not activated, the South Carolina Emergency Management Division (SCEMD) continues to monitor conditions and asks that all state agencies (which includes the South Carolina (SC) Wing through our Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) review their plans and procedures to prepare for assisting with this possible emergency.

The SC Wing Directors of Emergency Service and Communications have already issued instructions and checklists to squadrons and members. Squadrons should confirm to the Emergency Services Director that all aircraft are ready to fly and crews are prepared to fly hurricane evacuation routes. As a confidence check of capabilities, all members with communications equipment should plan to participate in the nets that will occur tonight. The communications master plan will be posted in the Document Library on the Paperless Wing.
